  - cancer #1 disease killing children but going down.
  - average age for children to be diagnosed with cancer is age 6
  - There are now quite a few 50 year survivors
- Seattle Children's program works with Fred Hutchinson and UW
- Scorpion venom,,,,,,,,, retraining T-cells,,,,,,,,,gene therapy.....are being discovered and improved by grants to doctors.
  - Big gains fighting osteogenic sarcoma, Dr. Tom said smoke from cannabis can cause cancer just like tobacco.

**About KCCP-** The Kiwanis Children's Cancer Program, KCCP, in support of Kiwanis Doernbecher Children's Cancer Program in Portland OR., Kiwanis Children's Cancer Program in Seattle WA. and the Kiwanis Children's Cancer Program in British Columbia and the Yukon, raise money and awareness to fight and find the cure for children's cancer. The KCCP was founded by Past Governor Dr. Frank Morehouse of the Pacific Northwest District of Kiwanis International in 2010. Past Governor Frank's inspiration was a young cancer patient named Penny. Past Governor Frank worked at the hospital where Penny stayed. Penny was diagnosed with a brain tumor and would require surgery and radiation therapy. Penny would visit Past Governor Frank during her hospital stays and talk about what was happening to her. Penny eventually lost her battle with cancer. The KCCP is dedicated to Penny's memory. The goal of the KCCP is to fund 3 or more Fellowships at the three hospitals in our district. To achieve this goal we will hold district fundraisers, seek public donations, corporate sponsors and receive funds from our clubs in the Pacific Northwest District. ### Criteria for the Jack Delf Distinguished Service Medal

1. The name of this award to be presented on behalf of the Past Governors of the Pacific Northwest District of Kiwanis International shall be known as: The Jack Delf Distinguished Service Medal
2. Eligibility for this medal is as follows but the Past Governors may change the criteria for this award at any time they deem appropriate.
  - A. Recipient must have actively served in Kiwanis for a period of not less than ten years.
  - B. Must have served in the Pacific Northwest District at least as a Lt. Governor or District Chairman.
  - C. Have actively participated outside of Kiwanis in other worthy community, lodge, or civic endeavors.
  - D. Must be nominated by a Kiwanis club which is currently in good standing with the Pacific Northwest District and Kiwanis International.
  - E. Be endorsed by the nominee's club board of directors as worthy of receiving such an award, and the nominator and nominee's club must submit evidential material in support of their recommendation.
  - F. Nominee may be living or deceased.
3. Nominee's biographic information together with supporting material must be submitted by the nominators to the Past Governors Committee in care of the Kiwanis District Office by June 1st of the Kiwanis year that the award will be considered. The award, if any, will be presented at the District Convention of that Kiwanis year.
4. The Past Governors selection committee, at its discretion, may honor more than one individual each Kiwanis year, but is not bound to select any nominee to receive an award.
